

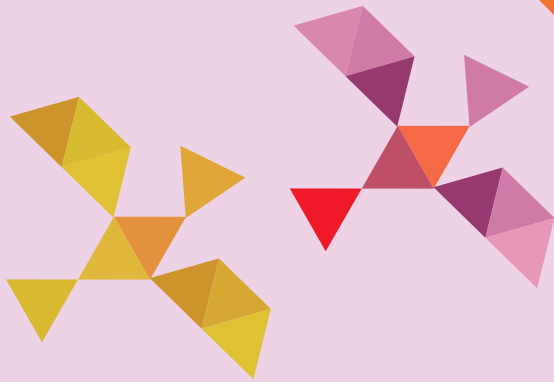

The Catalyst is an innovation challenge where students become EdTech developers. The goal is to design an original educational tool that simplifies complex scientific concepts through technology making learning faster, easier, and more fun.

THE CHALLENGE

- * The teams must be prepared to showcase scientific concepts for grades 6 to 12.
- * The specific stream (Physics, Chemistry or Biology) will be assigned on the spot via lot picking.
- * Teams will have exactly 2 hours to assemble and finalise their learning tool from scratch.
- * The tool must incorporate ICT in at least one of the following forms:
 - Gamified Learning or Mobile Apps
 - Web-based Platforms
 - AI-driven solutions
 - IoT (Internet of Things)
 - Original gadgets or hardware devices

- * Participants must bring all necessary hardware, including laptops, tablets, phones, adapters, and project materials.
- * While venue Wi-Fi may be available, teams are strongly encouraged to bring their own mobile hotspots as a backup.
- * Following the build phase, teams will demonstrate their project to the panel of judges.

We are not looking for just volume, but precision, blend and the magic that happens when the band meets vocal harmony.

INSTRUCTIONS

- Each team must consist of exactly 8 members (4 Vocalists and 4 Instrumentalists).
- Performances must feature vocal harmony (e.g., SATB, SAT, or similar vocal arrangements).
- All songs must be performed in English and Malayalam.
- Karaoke and pre-recorded loops and rhythm are not allowed.
- Equipment & Logistics:
 - ❖ Drums: A standard drum kit will be provided by the host school.
 - ❖ Other Instruments: All other instruments (Guitars, Keyboards, Processors, etc.) must be brought by the participants.

JUDGING CRITERIA

The jury will evaluate the performances based on the following professional standards:

- Vocal Harmony & Blend: Accuracy of the arrangement, pitch stability and the ability of the four voices to merge into a single, cohesive sound.
 - Instrumental Tightness: Technical proficiency, rhythm consistency and the ability of the instrumentalists to support the vocalists, and bring the beauty out of the vocals.
 - Musical Arrangement: Creativity and originality in how the song is adapted for an 8-piece ensemble.
 - Stage Presence & Performance: Overall energy, confidence, and the professional "look and feel" of the band on stage.
 - Technical Discipline: Efficiency during the 15-minute slot, including setup and sound check transitions and song transitions.
- Timing: Each team is allotted a total of 15 minutes.
This includes:
1. Stage Entry & Setup
 2. Sound Check
 3. Performance
 4. Stage Exit
- ❖ Note:
Strict adherence to the time limit is required to avoid point deduction.
